Sweden is a racing nation on the up. We have plenty of black type opportunities and larger purses than most people realise. We are not even that far away. Give it a go - before everyone else does.

The Stockholm Cup International day at Bro Park in Stockholm on the 18th of September features four black type races. The main race of the day is the Group 3 Stockholm Cup, a 12f turf race which boasts a purse of approximately €132,000. The Tattersalls Nickes Minneslöpning, a Listed race over a mile on the dirt course, is the perfect European trial for the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile or other North American dirt races.

How to get a horse to Sweden? Don't worry - it is easy. We take away all the administrative efforts of travelling horses to Sweden. Any horse wishing to compete on the Stockholm Cup day will be able to use road transport provided by Svensk Galopp. The transport leaves from Newmarket on Wednesday the 14th of September and returns on Monday the 19th of September.

Bro Park - the new home of horse racing in Stockholm

Bro Park opened in 2016, replacing Täby Galopp as the home of racing in the Swedish capital. Race meetings are regularly staged on both turf and dirt at the new facility that is owned by Svensk Galopp (the Swedish Horseracing Authority). It stages some of the most important races in Scandinavia, including the Swedish 2000 and 1000 Guineas in May, the Group 3 Stockholms Stora Pris in June, and the Group 3 Stockholm Cup International in September.

The racecourse is located in the town of Bro, approximately 35 minutes from the centre of Stockholm by car and a similar distance from Arlanda Airport.

Bro Park has an impressive 2100m turf course, a 1900m dirt track on the inside, and separate courses for steeplechase and hurdling. The racecourse and training centre cover an area of approximately 500 acres and has permanent stabling and training facilities for 300 horses with the capacity to accommodate a further 100 on race days.

The turf track


The turf track is a lefthanded, galloping track with long and sweeping bends. The circumference is 2100m (10.5f). The track has hardly any undulations.

Races run at 1600m (8f), 1750 m (8f 154yds) and 2100m (10.5f) are started on their own separate chutes. The straight is slightly over 400m (2f) long.

The dirt track

The dirt track at Bro Park is a left-handed track inside of the turf track.

The straight is 400m (2f) and the circumference is 1900m (9.5f). The 1600m (8f) races are started from a chute from the inside of the track.

Supplementary nominations

Supplementary nominations for The Stockholm Cup International will be accepted not later than 4th September with the payment of 22,000 SEK and a declaration not later than 9.30 a.m. (local time) on 12th September with the payment of 13,000 SEK.

Elimination

There will be no declaration fee if the horse is eliminated due to the maximum runners. The Stockholm Cup International has a maximum of 15 runners. The runners will be reduced by the elimination of those which, in the opinion of the Scandinavian Handicapper, have the lowest handicap rating.

Swedish V.A.T. charge

A 6% Swedish V.A.T. charge will be added to all entries and declaration fees.

Travel allowances

For each horse trained outside Scandinavia participating in Listed and Group races, travel allowances and contribution towards boarding will be subject to agreements. Contact the Swedish Horseracing Authority or the International Racing Bureau for more information.
